The Parent Resource Service office is located in the Carl B. Hutcherson Building at 2401 High Street.

- * Take Main St exit, EXIT 1, toward Downtown/Lower Basin/Riverfront. Go to the end of Main St. where the road ends.
- * Turn Right onto Buena Vista St and go to the end. White Rock Head Start will be on your left.
- *Turn Left onto Poplar St. You will see a green sign that says Hutcherson Early Learning Center.
- *Turn Right onto Harvey St. Continue straight and you will see the Hutcherson building at the bottom of the hill. (Do not turn onto High Street).
