What is intersession?

It is a five-day opportunity after the nine weeks for students to get additional remediation time with smaller group instruction.

Do all students attend intersession?

No. Students are invited to attend intersession if they are identified as needing additional help. Students who attend intersession are also invited for enrichment.

Is breakfast and lunch provided during intersession?

Yes. 94.5 % of Bass students are on free and reduced lunch, so intersession not only ensures they get the academic help they need, but that they also have two healthy meals.

• Is transportation provided during intersession? Yes.

Do all staff members work during intersession?

No. Staff members are required to work only one intersession and have the other four intersessions off.

• Are there childcare opportunities for children who do not attend intersession?

Yes. William Marvin Bass works with several community outreach programs and centers that are open for students whose families cannot afford childcare during intersession weeks.



What do the teachers, parents and students say about year-round school?

As educators we all scream, "WE NEED MORE TIME, WE NEED MORE TIME!" Bass, with its extended year program, has found a way to have *more time*. Our job as educators is to find the time and provide every learning experience necessary for a child to feel prepared and confident academically.
