Dear Parents:

As a parent of a student at Dearington Elementary School for Innovation, receiving Title I, Part A funds, you have the right to know the state accreditation and federal accountability status of our school. For the 2021-2022 (based on spring 2021 testing) school year, Dearington's current accreditation status is: **Accreditation Waived**. Additionally, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers instructing your child(ren). Federal law requires the school division to provide you this information in a timely manner if you request it. Specifically, you have the right to request the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Whether the teacher(s) have met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- > Whether the teacher(s) are teaching under emergency or other provisional status because of special circumstances;
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification or degree he/she has received;
- Whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and if so, their qualifications.
