

## Heritage Elementary Supply Lists – 09-10

### 2009-2010 Pre-Kindergarten Supply List

- 2 changes of clothes (uniforms - each piece labeled)
- 3 packs of markers
- 3 boxes of crayons (please no fat crayons)
- 6 packs of dry erase markers
- 10 glue sticks
- 1 box of Ziploc gallon storage bags
- 1 box of Ziploc small storage bags (please no snack size)
- 2 big pencils
- 2 tubs baby wipes
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 mat or sleeping bag
- 2 towels (labeled)
- 6 pocket folders
- 3 4-packs of playdoh (12 cans of playdoh)
- 1 school supply box
- 1 regular size backpack (one that will hold a folder)
- 4 boxes of tissues

### 2009-2010 Kindergarten Supply List

- Backpack
- 1 tub of baby wipes
- Girls – 1 box of sandwich size zipper seal bags
- Boys – 1 box of gallon size slide-lock bags
- 1 Marbled composition notebook
- 3 pocket folders
- 3 bottles of glue
- 4 glue sticks
- 3 boxes of Crayola brand crayons(24 pack)
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors (no plastic scissors)
- Pencils ( 2 packs of 10)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 crayon box
- 1 pack of expo dry erase markers
- 2 writing tablets from school store (\$1.75 each)

One set of clean clothes (underwear, pants, socks) folded as flat as possible and placed in a large zip lock bag with the student's name written on the bag in permanent marker. These clothes will be used if your child's clothes become soiled. Label all possessions with their name. Send all monies in an envelope with child's name and purpose of money.

### 2009-2010 First Grade Supply List

- 1 Backpack
- 3 Composition books (stiff covered—black and white marbled)
- 2 Boxes of Crayons (24 count boxes only) (\$.85 in school store)
- 1 Crayola Washable Markers set—Classic Colors—8 count box – fat markers
- 6 First grade writing tablets ( \$1.75 in school store)
- 1 Medium size Elmer's White School Glue (\$.85 in school store)
- 1 pack of pencils
- 2 Large boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 4Two-pocket folders with bottom pockets
- 1 Pencil box -- plastic
- 1 Fiskar scissors (\$1.75 purchased from school store)
- 4 Glue sticks
- Nutritious snack (no cakes,chips,cookies, candy bars, or pudding)

**PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS.**

The first grade teachers have requested that for some items, certain brand names be purchased. These requests are based on the experiences of children using other brands of school supplies. Bargain and other brands usually cause frustration because they often break or fail to work properly.

The teachers collect some of the supplies and keep them until they are needed. Please remind your child that school supplies belong at school and not to bring crayons, scissors, notebooks, etc., home!

First graders **DO NOT** need Trapper Keeper type notebooks, rulers, novelty erasers, or pencil sharpeners. Please keep these items at home. Thank you

- 1 large boxes of tissues

- 1 large box of crayons (64 crayons)
- 1 box of 12 color pencils
- 1 large bottle of Elmer's Glue All
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 two-pocket folders
- 3 second grade writing tablets (\$1.75 at school store)
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors (\$1.75 at school store)
- 1 plastic school box
- 2 packages wide rule notebook paper (150 packs)
- 2 package (24) pencils (#2 pencils only)
- 1-1 ½ inch notebook binder

**2009-2010 Third Grade Supply List**

- 8 Composition notebooks “marbled ones”, any color
- 2 Boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 Box of markers OR colored pencils
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 2 Bottle of white glue
- 8 Glue sticks
- 1 Crayon box soft zipper one is best (Hard plastic ones break easily!)
- 8 Two pocket folders
- 2 Packs of Loose Leaf Notebook Paper
- 1 Ruler—standard and metric marks
- 6 Packages of number two pencils
- 2 Pair of scissors (they get lost so easily)
- 4 Red pens
- 4 highlighters
- 1 Package of 3x5 index cards
- 1 Small pencil sharpener
- 1 Box of Ziplock Sandwich bags
- 1 Large pink eraser or pencil cap erasers

**Please do not send Trapper Keeper or Mechanical pencils. Our desks are not large enough to hold Trapper Keepers and the pencils become distracting. Please label all supplies with your child’s name in permanent marker. We will put subjects on each of the notebooks and folders. Any extra supplies will be labeled and held by the child’s homeroom teacher, and will be given out when needed.**

**2009-2010 Fourth Grade Supply List**

- \*No Lead Pencils!

- 1-1½ inch binder
- 5 Packages wide rule notebook paper
- 1 pencil bag
- 1 Package of Crayola Twistable Colored Pencils (12 count)
- 3 Big glue sticks
- scissors
- \*1 Box of Crayons
- \*1 Package of markers
- \*2 Boxes of tissues
- \*1 Box of multiplication flashcards (home use)
- \*4 Highlighters (any color)
- \*3 Packages of wooden #2 pencils
- \*1 Set of 4 dry erase markers
- 4 vinyl 2 pocket folders (1 green, 1 blue, 1 red, 1 yellow)

\*These supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year as needed.

**2009-2010 Fifth Grade Supply List**

- 5 plain folders with pockets inside
- 5 separate spiral composition books
- 1 spiral composition book for music
- 2 500 sheet packs of loose leaf notebook paper
- 4 packs #2 pencils with erasers
- 1 package of red pens (for checking papers)
- 1 pair of pointed scissors
- 2 Large boxes of tissues
- 1 Bottle white school glue (no colored glue) and glue stick
- 1 package of colored pencils or crayons
- 1 package of index cards (lined or unlined)
- 1 zippered bag for pencils (no boxes)

- \* No mechanical lead pencils
- \* No permanent markers

Students are expected to have these supplies on the first day of school and replenish them throughout the school year as needed. Teachers cannot provide supplies for students. Some items can be purchased in the school store. Please label all personal items with permanent name tags or markers.
