# TRANSFER OF CREDITS

- o Credits are designed to transfer to four-year schools. Students should enter as freshman for financial benefits.
- o Early College students should acquaint themselves with the requirements of the four-year school to which transfer is planned.

# APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications are made available at the high school Guidance Office in December.
- Applicants must have completed Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, and have strong math skills.
- Applicants are evaluated on:
  - Activities, leadership, and honors
  - GPA: must be 3.5 or above
  - Rigor of Academic Courses
  - Attendance
  - Teacher recommendations
  - CVCC Placement Test Scores (English and Math)
    - Students MUST apply online with CVCC before placement tests can be taken.



# TUITION AND FEES

- o Tuition is set by the State Board for Community Colleges
- o Tuition is approximately **40%** of the cost of a state four-year school
- o Tuition Junior year: approximately **\$5,000**
- o Tuition Senior year: approximately **\$4,800**
- o Parents are responsible for tuition
- o Textbooks: approximately **\$900-\$1000** per year and paid for by Lynchburg City Schools

# PELL GRANT

- The Department of Education is inviting 44 postsecondary institutions to participate in an experiment that for the first time allows students taking college-credit courses to access Federal Pell Grants as early as high school.
- CVCC was awarded a portion of this grant.
- You must apply online through Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with your parent's. They will need their previous year tax returns for the application process.
- Students who qualify for free or reduced-cost school lunch will be most likely to receive a Pell Grant



# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Transportation provided
- Daily class schedule/attendance
- School calendar/CVCC calendar
- Eligibility to continue in program: must complete **all first-year courses** prior to start of second year.
- Students are expected to follow the policies as stated in the student handbook which include maintaining at 2.0 GPA.
- Math & Biology: A **C** or better is required in all Math and Biology classes in order to continue to the next class sequence.
