Students can only take one online course in the summer.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Deadline to request student-initiated changes to course selections is <b>Friday, June 5, 2020.</b></li><li>• We will adhere to prerequisites noted in the Program of Studies and our ECG policies/procedures.</li><li>• Students have the first ten (10) days of school to request a schedule change by completing a Schedule Change Form.</li><li>• Students have five (5) days after first quarter report cards are distributed to request a level change, i.e. Advanced to Regular and in some instances we don’t have another level or there isn’t space available. To request a level change, students must complete a Level Change Request Form.</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Highlighted Graduation Requirements</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students must complete at least two sequential electives which are required for the Standard and Advanced Studies diploma options.</li><li>• Students shall successfully complete one virtual course, which may be a non-credit bearing or a required or elective credit bearing course that is offered online.</li><li>• Students must complete an Advanced Placement, honors, dual enrollment course OR earn a career and technical education credential.</li><li>• All students must take the following SOL tests in high school:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Math SOL test</li><li>○ Biology SOL test</li><li>○ History SOL test</li><li>○ English Writing SOL test</li><li>○ English Reading SOL test</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><b><u>Advanced Placement/Dual Enrollment</u></b></p> <p>All students enrolled in an <b>AP</b> course must take the AP exam in May 2021. The AP exam fee is \$40 per each AP exam; there is a reduced fee of \$15 for students who receive free/reduced lunch (documentation is required).</p> <p>In order to participate in the <b>dual enrollment</b> (DE) program, students must apply to CVCC (please keep track of your CVCC username and student ID number) and meet course requirements, by taking the English and math VPT tests.</p>
