## LAUREL Guidelines For <u>Student</u> Positive Screening Protocol While On Campus

Diagnosis, No Symptoms	Symptoms
Student shares they were"diagnosed" with COVID-19 less than 10 days ago, but does NOT have symptoms	Student has at least 1 of the following COVID-19 symptoms: Fever, Chills, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, New cough, New loss of taste/smell
<ul> <li><u>Action</u></li> <li>Remain in current location</li> <li>Require appropriate face covering of everyone in immediate area</li> <li>Increase social distance of others in immediate area- ensuring student remains under visual supervision, provide support</li> <li>Call for nurse to assess student</li> <li>Nurse enacts plan to send student home</li> <li>Close off areas used by the sick student</li> <li>Wait at least 24 hours, then clean and disinfect area with an EPA registered product</li> <li>Can return to school after at least 10 days since first positive COVID- 19 test, IF they have NOT subsequently developed symptoms since their positive</li> </ul>	<ul> <li><u>Action</u></li> <li>Remain in current location</li> <li>Require appropriate face covering for the ill student (if tolerated) and of everyone in that location</li> <li>Increase social distance of all others in the location- ensuring the sick student remains under visual supervision, providing emergency support if necessary (<u>NOTE: if</u> shortness of breath, bluish lips, difficulty breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, inability to stay awake is observed Call 911 to respond immediately!)</li> <li>Call for nurse to assess student home, if no observed signs of distress as listed above in red</li> <li>Close off and ventilate facility areas used by the sick student</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Student shares they were "diagnosed" with COVID-19 less than 10 days ago, but does NOT have symptoms</li> <li>Action</li> <li>Remain in current location</li> <li>Require appropriate face covering of everyone in immediate area</li> <li>Increase social distance of others in immediate area ensuring student remains under visual supervision, provide support</li> <li>Call for nurse to assess student</li> <li>Nurse enacts plan to send student home</li> <li>Close off areas used by the sick student</li> <li>Wait at least 24 hours, then clean and disinfect area with an EPA registered product</li> <li>Can return to school after at least 10 days since first positive COVID-19 test, IF they have NOT subsequently developed</li> </ul>

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		allowing student return to school https://www.cdc.gov/coronaviru s/2019-ncov/hcp/disposition-in- home- patients.html	<ul> <li>If a student has a <u>negative</u> COVID- 19 test, they can return to school once there is NO fever without the use of fever reducing medications AND they have felt well for 24 hours</li> <li>If a student has a <u>positive</u> COVID- 19 test OR diagnosed with COVID- 19 test OR diagnosed with COVID- 19 based on symptoms OR has not been tested BUT has had symptoms - they can return to school when:         <ul> <li>At least 72 hours have passed since recovery (defined as resolution of fever without the the use of fever reducing medications); AND</li> <li>Improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath, etc); AND</li> <li>At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; OR a healthcare to school in accordance with school district office of education policy allowing student return to school</li> </ul> </li> <li>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019- ncov/hcp/disposition-in-home- patients.html</li> <li>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019- ncov/symptoms- testing/symptoms.html#seek-medical- attention</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Nurse enacts plan to safely send student home as quickly as possible</li> <li>Nurse notifies the Director.</li> <li>Director notifies the Regional Superintendent and other division representatives as needed.</li> <li>Nurse and Director will contact the Local Health Departments (Lynchburg as well as the county the student is a resident of and institute any recommended procedures)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Nurse accompanies student (wearing cloth face covering) to designated isolation area</li> <li>Nurse enacts plan to safely and quickly get student home</li> <li>Student remains in isolation, under visual observation until picked up</li> <li>Nurse quickly notifies the Director.</li> <li>Director notifies the Regional Superintendent and other division representatives as needed.</li> <li>Nurse and Director will contact the Local Health Departments (Lynchburg as well as the county the student is a resident of and institute any recommended procedures)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Nurse accompanies sick student (wearing cloth face covering and maintaining 6 feet social distance) to designated isolation area</li> <li>IF the student is well enough, nurse enacts plan to immediately send student home. If the student is displaying any of the emergency warning signs of COVID-19 (shortness of breath, bluish lips, difficulty breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, inability to stay awake), supervising adult immediately calls 911</li> <li>Nurse quickly notifies the Director.</li> <li>Director notifies the Regional Superintendent and other division representatives as needed.</li> <li>Nurse and Director will contact the Local Health Departments (Lynchburg as well as the county the student is a resident of and institute any recommended procedures)</li> </ul>
