So that you are aware, for SOL testing, a perfect score is a 600, advanced scores fall between 500-599, and a passing score falls between 400-499. If a student scores between 375-399, they will be eligible to retake the test for a higher score. We will be providing support for those students as soon as we learn their scores. - Students not complying with this policy will be asked to cover the noncomplying clothing, change clothes, or go home."
