



SMS Sunday Message: October 18

Good evening, Spartan Family! This is Matthew A. Mason, proud principal of Sandusky Middle School, and here is the Sunday Message for the week of October 19 - 23. This message has been forwarded to our SMS family via email and can also be found on our website under the Sunday Message tab.

- Parents, this is a reminder that 6th grade students who designated "Hybrid" as their preferred learning model began in-face learning on Tuesday, October 13. We had a very successful first week with our Cohort A and Cohort B students! Just some reminders: If you are dropping off your child, please use the student drop off loop and not our bus loop. Water bottles are permissible as we have a touchless filling station in our cafeteria. Students need only bring items in their book bags for blocks 1 4 on Tuesday (Cohort A) and Thursday (Cohort B) and blocks 5 8 on Wednesday (Cohort A) and Friday (Cohort B). Lastly, Lynchburg City Schools is providing three days worth of food (breakfast and lunch) on Wednesdays (Cohort A) and Fridays (Cohort B). This food is optional for students, and we appreciate the school system for providing this opportunity.
- Families, starting on Tuesday, October 13, the Remote Learning schedule that students had been using to Zoom with their teachers ceased to be used. With about half of our students returning for the hybrid model, we began using our regular schedule for both remote and hybrid students. Students will be able to Zoom to attend regular class periods. Teachers will give direction on when the best time is to Zoom into a class. Students will still have the ability to schedule a Zoom meeting with a teacher on Monday afternoons, and we will also be providing Zoom times for specific periods from 2:45 3:15. This gives added time for Zooming opportunities with our remote students. Again, this began on Tuesday, October 13. Our school schedule can also be found on our website under the "About Us" tab. Finally, please reach out to your child's teacher first if you have concerns with your students' success in the classroom. We will always direct you there first if those are your concerns.
