Meals must be consumed on school grounds, so if you would like your child to receive a meal, they would need to participate in an afterschool program or be picked up by 3:25 pm. Students will receive a sandwich, vegetable, fruit, and milk. We appreciate our LCS Nutrition department for providing this opportunity for our kids!
