Please encourage your student to READ at home. A recent Renaissance study of more than 9.9 million students found that only those students who read <u>15 minutes or more</u> per day made accelerated reading gains. Students who had less than 15 minutes of daily-engaged reading time saw below-average reading gains. Students who read between just over a half-hour and an hour per day saw the greatest gains of all.

Counselor's Corner

Happy February! This month, TCM will focus on self-control. Self-control is defined as the ability to control one's impulses, emotions, and actions. Self-control is a skill that can be learned and fine-tuned. Our character education bulletin board will feature the idea: I cannot control ANYONE ELSE, but I can control MYSELF: my thoughts, my actions, my reactions, my words, my choices, and my future.
